This letter is written to express opposition to the **SEQR Delaware River Large Scale Power Plant**, which is proposed for farmland near the intersection of Fox Road and Yellow Mills Road. Allowing this variance and the resulting construction of a power plant directly contradicts the *Town of Farmington Comprehensive Master Plan*. To cite just a few examples:

- Goal #3, Conservation, Open Space and Environmental Protection states, "to preserve the natural environment and protect it from degradation".
- Goal #4B, Commerce states, "to provide for a limited number of small-scale, neighborhood-oriented commercial areas which are safe and attractive".
- Goal #4C, Agriculture states, "to enhance agricultural viability and preserve agricultural land resources".
- Goal #4D, Industrial states, "to plan certain areas for non-intrusive industrial development in order to provide a variety of employment opportunities and increase the tax base".

While I am no expert on town policy, procedure, or politics, and while reading further into the *Town of Farmington Comprehensive Master Plan*, it appears that allowing construction of this project goes against everything the Town of Farmington values in terms of preserving the beauty and character of our area.

*You, as the Town Planning Board, have the power to say, "no" to this project. Please be brave enough to do so.*
