What IS a disciple, anyway?

The other day I was driving one of my Uber customers, who was probably 30 years old. I picked her up from her job at Target and took her home. I asked her how her day was, as I usually do, and she said it was ROUGH! She was quiet most of the way to her apartment, but when we got there, she had a hard time getting the app on her phone to open the gate. She apologized and said she was distracted because she was listening to this incredible song that was making her rough day better. She said it was called, "The Promise", by a band called "When In Rome". I said I knew it well and loved it! I told her that it reminded me of my best friend growing up, Mindi, because the song is about being there for someone no matter what. Mindi made a mix tape that included that song for me (in like 1990!) and it was really comforting to me after my dad died. Those were very formative years for me in my early teens and that song and Mindi's friendship were crucial to God forming me to become the disciple of Jesus that I am.

We've all been there. Identity formation is an integral part of the maturing process for teenagers. I would argue that identity formation continues until the day we close our eyes for the last time. There are so many factors that shape who we are, but ultimately, God has chosen and created us for the identity he ordained for us before the beginning of time. All other factors can help shape us into who he wants us to be, or lead us astray into some other identity. What is the most important aspect of your identity? I would argue that it is as a follower of Christ, if you have claimed him as your savior and lord.



No other aspect of who you are is as eternally and temporally important than your faith in Christ. God has created you in his image and for a purpose, and following Jesus is the most important purpose for all of us. That identity affects everything about our lives. Or at least it should. The way we talk, the way we treat people, how we do our jobs, how we raise our kids, our interactions with our friend, everything should reflect who we are in Christ. If I'm honest, I have to admit it doesn't always work out that way. I am not always the best reflection of Jesus in my life.

So we all can do better in living out our identity in Jesus. That process of learning who we are and living it out is called discipleship. It is the process of learning and living who

vou are as a follower of Jesus. As part of our denominational renewal process, our Discipleship Ministry Team has developed a definition of what a disciple of Jesus looks like. They have prayerfully discerned and articulated several traits of a disciple. Last year I preached a sermon series in May and June that presents and explained those traits. This year we, the leadership of Peace Church, have decided to make discipleship our number 1 priority. I made that clear to the Session at our retreat in January. but I am realizing I have not made it clear to the whole congregation! Our emphasis on discipleship is why we did the small groups on "The Chosen" TV show for Lent, why I've emphasized reading the whole Bible through in 2024 using the Youversion app, why we took a youth retreat to go camping, and why ALL of my sermon series this year will have that focus. I encourage you all to be praying for God to more clearly reveal to vou his love in Christ and vour identity in Christ as we embark on this journey of discipleship discovery. In that way we will all

be able to say we are disciples of Jesus Christ first and foremost! Remember, you are a disciple: it's who you are MEANT to be!
