



C A R E Care Team's next meeting will be in January 2025.



Holiday Food Challenge Results! We wrapped up our Holiday Food Challenge last week as we collect food for Christian Helping Hands ahead of the busy holiday rush of needs that they face. This year we had a NEW food challenge partner (opponent!) in Mosaic Church, who competed with us to see who could donate the most food by pound per attendee. Nov. 24th totals: Peace collected 180 pounds with

28 people in worship (avg 6.43 lbs per person); Mosaic collected 265 pounds with 63 people in worship (avg 4.21 lbs per person). Total pounds of food collected by **Peace through 11/24: 542 lbs (3.6 lbs per person**). Total pounds of food collected by **Mosaic through 11/24: 755 lbs (2.7 lbs per person**).

Sheila Marshall - Elder - Nominated for the Outreach & Mission




