

Regular Board Meeting  
February 9, 2011  
City Hall, 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Snook, also present were aldermen Staley Snook and Marshall Welch, Aldermen Cook and Bressman was absent.

Spiers led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Snook moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read, Welch moved to second motion carried with the mayor casting the third yes vote.

Welch moved to pay the expenditures as presented, Snook seconded, motion carried with the mayor casting the third yes vote.

Masoner advised the board that Plattsburg had informed her of a slight increase in the water rate and would result in an increase of .50 per customer per month. Welch moved to adjust, motion died for lack of a second. The matter was tabled until March. She also advised the board that there is an impediment to traffic flow on Hines due to two vehicles parking parallel to each other and not leaving enough room for vehicles to pass. Jeff will speak to the parties.

Spiers reported no water leaks for the previous month and reported lots of snow removal to streets.

Bruner reported a combined total of 125 hours worked with 9 call outs that included 1 harassment, 1 fire, 5 animal complaints, 1 keep the peace and 1 possible break in.

The clerk advised that she had spoken with alderman Cook and that cook had some concerns with the new Sports Association contract.
