

REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 2, 2011  
City Hall, 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor James Snook, also present were aldermen Marshall Welch, Staley Snook, Lloyd Bressman and Charlene Cook.

Spiers led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Snook moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as read, Cook seconded, motion carried (4-0)

Welch moved to pay the expenditures as presented, Bressman seconded, motion carried (4-0)

The clerk advised the board that Gary Weber of Missouri Rural Water Association will be at city hall on June 7th @ 9:30. She also noted that the annual animal clinic had netted \$751.00

Spiers reported a small leak at the intersection of Aller and Lewis and that the street repairs will begin in about 2 weeks. Spiers also noted that the previously approved mower had been purchased.

Bruner reported a combined total of 127 hours with 21 callouts and 10 tickets issued. Callouts included 8 peace disturbances, 3 dogs running at large, 6 information reports, 1 domestic violence, 1 phone harassment, 1 four wheeler on street, 1 alleged intoxication report. Bruner also advised the board that the air conditioner did not work on the police car and he was authorized to get it repaired

Bressman advised the board that the costs to have park appraisals done would be between \$1,000.00 and \$1,500.00. Cook moved to allow the appraisals done even if the county does not pay.

Some discussion ensued regarding inspections of trailers coming into the the trailer park in Edgerton, The board felt it was the responsibility of the building inspector and if there would be a problem to involve the police dept.

Snook moved to approve \$1,000.00 for the Pioneer Days festival, Bressman seconded, motion carried (4-0)

Lloyd Bressman is going to have Richard Mauton to replace the sidewalk in front of his house and the City will pay half. Snook so moved and Cook seconded, motion carried (3-yes Bressman abstained)

The school demolition will begin near the end of June and Lewis street will be repaired following the demolition.

Cook moved to adjourn, Snook seconded, motion caarried (4-0)
