I inspected this roof on July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023. I met the owner and got on the roof. The roof is a new TPO membrane.. One layer over plywood. Separate photo emails will be sent. Each will be numbered to correspond to the numbered items on the summary report. The following items should be noted:

 Seams, layout, perimeter detail is good except membrane must wrap over the edges of the roof. This was not done. See attached TPO documents. I do not know what brand of TPO this is. Doesn't matter. All TPO specs are the same.

2. Roof was prepped in a rainstorm according to the owner. Not the best choice

in this writer's opinion.

According to the owner there was zero leaking until after the new TPO was installed. The process of elimination coupled with simple logic indicates there are / were 'issues' with this install.

4. Above the leak areas at the front door and kitchen there are voids and openings. The opening above the kitchen is big enough to put your arm in. There should not be an opening here or anywhere else.

5. Roof to wall detail not correct. See attached pages.

According to the owner there was major damage to floors and ceilings and cabinets.

Conclusion: At some point the word 'integrity' comes in to play.






