

ORDINANCE NO. 87

ORDINANCE OF THE CUPERTINO SANITARY DISTRICT ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE SANITARY BOARD

Section 1: Pursuant to California Health & Safety code §6489 and California Water Code §20200 et seq., this Board has: (a) published notice of a public hearing pursuant to California Water Code §20203; (b) held a public hearing on October 17, 2001, at which any and all persons desiring to be heard on this subject were heard.

Section 2: Members of the Sanitary Board shall be compensated at the rate of \$210 for each meeting of the District Board attended by a member thereof or for each day's service rendered as a member by request of the Board, not exceeding a total of six (6) days in any calendar month, effective January 1, 2002.

Section 3: Existing District authorizations for repayment of expenses and calculations of each day's service as a member of the Board shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon expiration of sixty (60) days from the date of its passage and adoption.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly and properly introduced and adopted, after the close of a public hearing, on November 7, 2001, at a regular meeting of the Sanitary Board of the Cupertino Sanitary District, by the following roll call vote:




