Day 1: Read Romans 16:25-27, and consider the following:

- Paul proclaims that God is able to *establish you* according to the Gospel. Read also Ephesians 3:20-21 and Jude 1:24-25. What does it look like for you to be *established* in your faith relationship with God, through Jesus Christ?
- Paul ends Romans by saying it is God's plan that all believers would come to the *obedience of faith*. As disciples of Jesus, how is having faith in Christ inseparable from living in obedience to Christ? Take time to consider areas in your life where you know you are struggling with obedience to God. In these areas, how is God calling you to a greater faith and trust in Him and His Word?
