I am VERY excited about upcoming mission opportunities. Right now, I am recruiting skilled work teams to go to Houston to rebuild houses. I had hoped to have a team go in November, but that does not seem likely now. SO, we are aiming for the weeks of January 8-12/13 (Mon-Sat), January 14-20, January 28-February 3, or February 18-24. If you have a strong skill level in carpentry, plumbing, laying floor, electrician, and or painting, we need you. See which of these weeks work for you and contact the NKBA office to set it up. We have partners ready on the ground to provide housing and food. You will only need to secure your travel and a few limited meals. Limited resources are available to help with supplies for drywall (takes about \$1500 per home). Again, this is SKILLED labor...If you are interested CONTACT ME RIGHT AWAY!

The NKBA will have a Christmas Open House for all of our churches, pastors/staff/members on December 7 from Noon-7PM. Drop by for a bite to eat and to celebrate the season!

If you still haven't put a Christmas backpack together for distribution to our NKY/Greater Cincinnati area churches, you can! Our goal is 500 and statewide it is 5000! I am asking all NKBA churches to join together for 40 Days of Prayer in 2018! This would begin January 24 and end March 5. Prayer Guides will be available on our website and printed books available to guide this time for each church at the NKBA office.

To culminate this time, we will have an all-association Spiritual Awakening Conference on Friday and Saturday evening, March 2-3 at 7PM at Burlington Baptist Church. Coming to Northern Kentucky! June 16-22, 2018

Kentucky Changers is a ministry that provides middle and high school students with the opportunity to serve their community in the name of Christ. The students, along with adult volunteers, provide exterior home improvement and maintenance for qualified homeowners. KY Changers makes a life impact on everyone involved!

We are asking your church to get involved!

What can you do the help? Many things, including:

- ◆ Register your youth to serve that week. Any number of students in your church can participate!
- ◆ Be an adult volunteer to assist the work teams. Men and women with construction skills will teach the students the skills needed to complete the project..
- Host a crew of 10-14 at your church on Sunday morning for Sunday School, Worship, and a lunch. After lunch you will go with the crew to visit the homeowner and prayer walk the area. Monday through Thursday, your church will provide sack lunches to the jobsite and stay for lunch and devotion. (Lunches for all crews will be prepared at a central location.)
- Provide funding for materials! It costs between \$1,000-\$1,500 per home and we expect to do 20-30 homes in Northern Kentucky. Every church can contribute something, and every dollar matters!.
- Apply to receive home repair assistance. Call or email the NKBA at nkychangers18@gmail.com for an application.
- Pray. We need your prayers! We need someone from every church on our prayer team. Contact Lori at lorne@nkbaptist.org or at the NKBA office and sign up for our KY Changers prayer updates!

Volunteers Needed


Baptist Convalescent Center 120 Main Street, Newport, KY
