# Jim's Journal

## September 2021



Even though I gave my ordinary spot this month to share Dennis Pethers message with you about our Rooftop Encounter at the Radisson on October 2, we have another important need that I want to urgently put before you!

Many of you have been following the damage of Hurricane Ida, particularly in southern Louisiana. This has been a long-time partner area for the NKBA and once again, I want to ask you to help us help the people in Southern Louisiana. Over 1 million people are without power in Louisiana at the time I am writing this. As you know it has been a VERY HOT summer and that continues now.

Here is the need and the ask: We can purchase a generator here for \$600 that will power a household in Southern Louisiana. These would be distributed by our partners on the ground through the New Orleans Baptist Association to the areas and people who are most at risk. I would like to challenge each of our churches to purchase at least one generator to donate. You can send the money to the NKBA or if you want to purchase a generator and bring it to the NKBA (call in advance and let us know), we will be transporting all the generators that have been purchased at that time to Southern Louisiana. I would like to send our first shipment of generators on September 13.

My SECOND ASK is that we gather gift cards for family needs. These too will be distributed BY CHURCHES and leaders in that area, who know the people who are most AT RISK. I would like to ask for gift cards from \$20-\$500 from the following ONLY: WALMART, HOME DEPOT, LOWE'S, and CHICK-FIL-A. This will help people with necessities, repair, and a meal. SO, BEGIN NOW and let's collect as many as we can and we will send those to Southern Louisiana on September 13. We will continue to collect these, but want to get some help in their hands as quickly as it is possible. You can send these to the NKBA and we will report to you on how we have delivered these to our mission partners on the ground!

Thank you! You have always been extraordinarily generous in the past and I know you will do the same again NOW! HELP US HELP PEOPLE...we can't do everything, but let's do for the ONE what we would want to do for the many. Again, every gift card and generator will flow in and through local churches to help people most at risk.
