

WALK INTO HISTORY

The Duluth History Brick Program is a unique way to honor friends, loved ones or community leaders. We have four package plans and one of them (or more) is right for you! The future plans of the Duluth Historical Society include building a Heritage and Learning Center which will be located on the Southeastern Railway Museum property, just off Buford Highway in Duluth, GA. Proceeds from the brick program will help fund the association mission and this new center.

#1 PACKAGE *is for all our friends!*

Purchase a 4"x8" laser engraved brick which features either one or two lines of text (16 characters each). Personalized bricks will be installed around the historical Duluth Depot and will remain as part of the history of Duluth. Now is the time to help preserve Duluth's history by ordering a dedication brick to be included in this site.

#2 PACKAGE *is for Duluth First Families*

Are you a "first family"? The association is looking for families who have roots in Duluth from 1821–1965. Apply for your genealogy packet today! Contact Judy McCorkle at judykmcorkle@gmail.com. Family History Bricks are also available, 12" x 12" or 16" x 16". Your brick purchase includes:

- A 4"x8" brick, engraved with your family name and dates – more details on order form.
- A gift of a Limited Edition, uncirculated print of the Chattahoochee River ready to be framed for your enjoyment.
- Installation of your brick at the entrance of the historical Duluth Depot, reserved for first families only.

#3 PACKAGE *is for Duluth Fall Festival Volunteers!*

There is a special brick wall being built at the Duluth Depot. The association invites you to become part of history through the purchase of your brick package. This package includes:

- A 4"x8" brick engraved with your name or that of your loved one who volunteered and supported this annual festival. This is an honor system where volunteers throughout the 30+ years of the festival are to be recognized.
- A certificate of authenticity, signed by Kathryn Willis and Ann Odum, that these are the original building bricks of the Parsons building from 1925.
- A souvenir 100 year old brick for you to enjoy in your home, garden or office bearing this inscription "Parsons Duluth 1925-2015."


#4 PACKAGE *is for those who have or are still working on the train!*
