Dear Parents and Carers,

This week is Reconciliation Week which runs from 27th May to 3rd June. National Reconciliation Week (NRW) is a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures, and achievements, and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. A major focus of our school over the past few years has been sharing the true stories of the experiences of Aboriginal peoples and ensuring that our students understand that Australia was not a vacant land before white people arrived and that the arrival of white people in Australia had a huge impact on the way of life for Aboriginal people all over the country. Truth-telling enables a fuller and more accurate account of Australia's history to recognise the strength and contribution of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. It acknowledges the historical silencing of injustices and ongoing impacts of colonisation on First Nations people. Truth-telling is fundamental to advancing reconciliation. At school, some impacts of colonisation are discussed with students at an age appropriate level. Students have been exploring different milestones and creating a display which will be published in the office foyer later in the week. All families and the community are invited to come in and read over what the students have learnt. On Thursday this week, students will be moving into House groups for the middle session to continue their learning together. Thank you to Ms Anderson and Mrs Wassink for your organisation. School Photos 2025 – Eagle Point Primary School

Annual school photos have been taken by Arthur Reed Photos.

To view the images of your child and order photos, you will need to first register online.

Go to <https://order.arphotos.com.au> and enter the 2025 image code for your child (from their personalized flyer)

Tap on 'Add another child' to enter the image codes of any siblings

Fill in your email and mobile details and then review all details before confirming your registration

That's it! When 2025 photos are ready, you will be notified by email and SMS.

Even if you registered last year, it's important that you do it again each year using your child's new image code to link their photos for the current year with your contact details.

To ensure you are ordering school photos for the current year, please wait for notifications that 2025 images are online before placing orders.

In the webshop you can view photos and customize your photo package; Choose ANY layout, ANY image and purchase multiple digital image downloads.

All photo orders will be sent directly to the address you provide when ordering.
