**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A GARFIELD COUNTY FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE DISTRICT (“GCFMLD”) MINI GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 IN ORDER TO OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PURCHASING STREET SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND ERGONOMIC OFFICE EQUIPMENT FOR USE IN THE FIELD AND IN TOWN OFFICES WITHIN THE TOWN OF SILT, GARFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Silt (“Town”) is a municipal corporation, i.e. political subdivision, of the State of Colorado, and therefore is an eligible applicant for a grant awarded by the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District (“GCFMLD”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has submitted a Grant Application for the Town of Silt Safety and Ergonomics Purchasing Project, requesting a total award of \$25,000.00 from GCFMLD, with an overall budget of \$25,000.00 for such project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town wishes to purchase traffic control barricades and safety signage to increase safety and efficiency on construction projects throughout the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has a need for ergonomic office furniture to increase safety and reduce workplace injuries to staff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes that such grant would help relieve the Town of Silt general fund of the cost of such additional costs and impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of Trustees (“Board”) supports staff in its grant application for the Federal Mineral Lease District Mini Grant and if funded, ensures that such project will be complete as per the grant guidelines: and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILT COLORADO, that:**

**Section 1**

- 1) The above recitals are hereby incorporated as findings by the Town of Silt;
- 2) The Board strongly supports the Garfield County Federal Mineral Lease District Mini Grant application request in the amount of \$25,000.00, with a total budget of \$25,000.00 for the Town of Silt Street Safety and Ergonomics Project;

- 3) If the grant is awarded, the Board strongly supports the completion of the Town of Silt Street Safety and Ergonomics Project;
- 4) The Board authorizes the expenditure of in-kind labor necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded pursuant to a Grant Agreement with the GCFMLD for the Town of Silt Street Safety and Ergonomics Project;
- 5) The Town of Silt owns and operates the Town of Silt Town Hall and Town Shop, as well as all Town streets and such facilities will be owned by the Town for the next twenty-five (25) years.
- 6) The Town will continue to maintain the Town of Silt Town Hall, Town Shop, and Town streets in perpetuity;
- 7) If a grant is awarded, the Board hereby authorizes Town Administrator Jeff Layman to sign a Grant Agreement with the GCFMLD.

**Section 2**

This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
