NEW Mineral & Land Records System



The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is responsible for managing approximately 245 million acres of Federal surface estate and 700 million acres of subsurface mineral estate. In the past, miners would have accessed the BLM's Legacy Rehost system, commonly known as LR2000, to do research. While helpful, that system was also frustrating to use, so you'll be happy to know that LR2000 has been decommissioned and the NEW <u>Mineral Land Records</u> <u>System</u> (MLRS) has taken its place.

MLRS is a geospatially enabled online land information system that allows miners to more readily research land status, discover mining claim activity, file new claims, pay fees, and more. Signing up for a MLRS account is useful if you have business with the BLM involving mining claims. MLRS is free to use, and there are no additional fees to create an account. When you sign up for an MLRS account, you get access to several useful tools that will enhance your BLM experience— file and manage your claims, receive real-time status updates, access advanced mapping tools, and interact with the BLM online. You should register with MLRS if you are a: recreational miner, small mining business owner, large mining corporation employee, mining association member, or person who is interested in bookmarking research maps or saving your search results

Your account type is determined by your needs. Create a personal account if you own your claims as an individual and will be the only user within the

History Nugget: Custer, Idaho

They say all that glitters is not gold, which is especially true in the Gem State where garnets, opals, and jasper sparkle just as brightly as nuggets. But back in the late 1870s, it was mostly the gleam of gold that attracted prospectors to the



Yankee Fork of Idaho's Salmon River. And where gold glimmered yesterday, it often means intriguing gold rush ghost towns are found today. Custer, Idaho is a prime example.

Located in scenic central Idaho, the town of Custer started out in 1879 as the little sister to bigger Bonanza City (also a ghost town), two miles north. With the recent defeat of General Custer still fresh in their minds, the founding miners named the town in his honor. Custer was basically a single street—narrow and a half-mile long— with a Chinatown located at the southern end.

The 1880s brought rapid growth to the region as the Lucky Boy, Sunbeam,

With a capacity to process 900 tons of ore a month, the General Custer Mine alone produced an estimated \$8,000,000 in gold between 1880 and 1888 and was considered the mother lode of the Yankee Fork. Thanks to the economic support from the mines, Custer's population doubled by 1896. It even sported a schoolhouse, jail, Miner's Union Hall, and a baseball team. <u>Article continues...</u>
