

# Worship God With Praise and Thanksgiving

Always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. (*Ephesians 5:20*)

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. (*1 Thessalonians 5:16-18*)

I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds. I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the praises of your name, O Most High. (*Psalms 9:1-2*)

I will give to the Lord the thanks due to his righteousness, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord, the Most High. (*Psalms 7:17*)

Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into his presence with singing! Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name! For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations. (*Psalms 100:1-5*)

Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. (*Psalms 95:6-7*)

The trumpeters and musicians joined in unison to give praise and thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals and other instruments, the singers raised their voices in praise to the Lord and sang: "He is good; his love endures forever." (*2 Chronicles 5:13*)

Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High. (*Psalms 50:14*)

Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. (*Hebrews 13:15*)

Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (*Psalms 103:1-6*)

I will praise the name of God with a song; I will magnify him with thanksgiving. (*Psalms 69:30*)

Thanks be to God for his inexpressible gift! (*2 Corinthians 9:15*)

It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night, to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre. For you, O Lord, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy. How great are your works, O Lord! (*Psalms 92:1-5a*)

We give thanks to you, O God; we give thanks, for your name is near. We recount your wondrous deeds. (*Psalms 75:1*)

Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe. (*Hebrews 12:28*)

Praise the Lord! Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise him in the heights! Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his hosts! (*Psalms 148:1-2*)

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (*Colossians 3:16-17*)

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (*Philippians 4:4-7*)

Blessed be the Lord! For he has heard the voice of my pleas for mercy. The Lord is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped; my heart exults, and with my song I give thanks to him. (*Psalms 28:6-7*)

Job arose and tore his robe and shaved his head and fell on the ground and worshiped. And he said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord." (*Job 1:20-21*)

Praise the Lord! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens! Praise him for his mighty deeds; praise him according to his excellent greatness! Praise him with trumpet sound; praise him with lute and harp! Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and pipe! Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals! Let everything that has breath praise the Lord! Praise the Lord! (*Psalms 150:1-6*)

Let [the people] praise your great and awesome name! Holy is he! (*Psalms 99:3*)

With my mouth I will give great thanks to the Lord; I will praise him in the midst of the throng. (*Psalms 109:30*)

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (*1 Corinthians 15:57*)

O Lord, you are my God; I will exalt you; I will praise your name, for you have done wonderful things, plans formed of old, faithful and sure. (*Isaiah 25:1*)

For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen. (*Romans 11:36*)

And the twenty-four elders who sit on their thrones before God fell on their faces and worshiped God. (*Revelation 11:16*)

Lift up your hands to the holy place and bless the Lord! (*Psalms 134:2*)

And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" (*Isaiah 6:3*)

But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. (*John 4:23*)

And Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.'" (*Luke 4:8*)
