

Dance Leadership Positions and Descriptions

Dance Lead

Description:

- Head of the dance section within the band.
- Must be nominated and voted into position by dues paying dancers.

Responsibilities:

- Apoint Dance Sergeants and Dance Assistants as needed.
- Come up with lesson plans and goal orientation.
- Lead class.
- Have the ability and knowledge to teach from SOBHD textbook.
- Keep open communication with dancers, band and dance representative.

Performance Coordinator

Description:

- Work closely with the band to set up performances.
- Work with other parties interested in booking performances.
- Can be one of Dance Sergeants. But not necessary.

Responsibilities:

- Explore potential performance opportunities.
- Keep dancers up to date on upcoming performances.
- Keep open communication with the band.
- Assist Dance Lead when asked.
- Help lead class.
- Help plan lessons.
- Decide on best dances to perform for specific performances.

Dance Sergeants

Description:

- Assistant to Dance Lead.
- Must be 18 or older.
- Appointed by the Dance Lead as needed.
- Must show an active interest in position.

Responsibilities:

- Assist Dance Lead when asked.
- Help lead class.
- Coordinate with Dance lead, Performance Coordinator and other Dance Sergeants in lesson plans.

Dance Teaching Assistants

Description:

- Appointed by Dance Lead.
- Must be 16 or older.
- Must show an active interest in teaching and helping other classmates.

Responsibilities:

- Assist Dance Lead when asked.
- Help in class when asked. And only when asked.

Election Rules

- Election will be held every 2 years. (Around the same time as the band representatives are elected.)
- Must be nominated for election by a dues paying dancer.
- Must be 18 or older to run.
- Must be an active dues paying dancer to run.
- Must be an active dues paying dancer to vote.

Intentions:

The intention of this structure is to incorporate more people into the teaching and leadership of the Dance Core. By creating a team of leaders and teachers the work load will be spread more evenly and the knowledge and skill set of all the teaching team will be utilized. The ultimate goal is to improve the skills and performance quality of the Boise Highlander's Dance Core as a whole.
