

CAMP PHILOSOPHY

The camp will include the Cadet National Teams as well as Oregon's Cultural Exchange Team to Canada. There will be clinicians and coaches from around the State. The camp is designed to prepare Oregon's National Team members for the National Tournament in Fargo as well as prepare Oregon's Cultural Exchange Team. National and Cultural Exchange Teams focus will be in Freestyle and Greco-Roman while campers can chose to focus on Collegiate as well. Wrestlers will be involved in approximately 6 to 7 hours of championship wrestling instruction and training daily. Instruction is designed to motivate the average wrestler and challenge the more advanced. It is the goal of the camp directors that everyone who completes the camp will feel like they have developed skills and training methods that will enable him to reach his full potential as a wrestler.

Deposit and Balance: There will be a \$100 deposit to reserve a spot in the camp. There will be no refunds once they are accepted. This number will include National Team members. Contact Steve Thorpe for information. No Refund on camp fee if you cancel after June 1st. Total cost for camp is \$225.
