

Behavior Contract for Before/After Care and Summer Camp Students Ages 5 and older

When a school-aged child makes a choice to behave inappropriately the following are the consequences:

1. Discussion of expectation to behave appropriately and how to do so next time (Blue)
2. Second discussion of expectation to behave appropriately and how to do so next time and warning of consequence number 3 (Yellow)
3. Written notification to parent of three incidents of inappropriate behavior (Orange)
4. Phone call to parent, and/or teacher-parent conference (Red)

*Consequence 4 will be immediately pursued for destruction of property or harmful behavior towards self or others

** The Group Leader will decide how, if at all, to display the children's behavior progressions in the classroom

*** JOFCCD reserves the right to dis-enroll any child who consistently exhibits inappropriate behavior which endangers the welfare of the other children and/or interferes with the learning or proper care of others.

The following is excerpted from the Charles County Department of Community Services Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations:

- All bathers must shower before entering the pool
- No running, pushing, wrestling, or horseplay is permitted in or around the pool
- No food, candy, gum or drinks are permitted in the pool area
- Diving is prohibited
- Bathers are advised to stay away from main drains and inlets
- Only person who can demonstrate their swimming ability to the lifeguard's satisfaction will be permitted in deep water

- The use of kickboards, inner tubes, air mattresses, balls, flotation aids, water wings, etc. will be governed by the pool management based on hazards to swimmers. Children using flotation devices must be supervised by a staff member with arms reach and will not be permitted in the deep end
- The pool staff shall have the authority to close the pool when weather conditions so dictate. The pool will close during a thunderstorm.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers
- Any person suffering from diarrhea or waterborne transmittable communicable disease shall not be allowed in the pool
- Starting blocks are prohibited from use
- Children under the age 12 must be accompanied by a supervising adult. (JOFCCD will provide a 1-7 ratio during swimming trips as required by OCC licensing regulations)
- Obey lifeguards, pool staff and JOFCCD staff at all times

I have read these rules and regulations and discussed them with my child and understand that my child's cooperation and behavior directly affect his/her enrollment at JOFCCD.
