Overall points will determine the winner and first and second runner up.

Prize money: 1st \$1000.00, 2nd \$500.00, 3rd \$250.00

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All dancing events will be governed by the rules and regulations of the S.O.B.H.D. and ScotDance Canada.
- This competition will offer Premier and Restricted Premier classes according to the rules and regulations of the SOBHD and ScotDance Canada.
- Dancers will compete in reverse order of entry.
- The decisions of the judges are final.
- Age is as of Friday, August 2, 2019.
- Dancers must be in appropriate costume for presentation of awards and group photos.
- Dancers will be required to fill in for Reels as required.
- The 2019 Championship Steps must be danced for the Glengarry Open Championship.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine or divide all age groups at their discretion.
- Dancers reporting late for their dance may not be allowed to dance out of numerical order.
- Dancers must present a valid SOBHD dance registration card at time of registration.
- Entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- Any dancer who decides not to compete after having registered, or may have changed categories, is asked to notify the Registrar in advance.
- Cloth numbers must be returned at the conclusion of the competition or a \$10.00 fee will be incurred.
- No dance mats or boards will be permitted outside of the designated warm-up area. No warming up in the seating area.
- No parents permitted behind the stage area.

 In accordance with the ScotDance Canada Risk Management Policies, dancers must not change costumes in public view or in public washrooms. Dancers must use the provided secured changing facilities ONLY. Dancers in violation of this policy will be asked to leave the area until properly dressed and will have their names forwarded to the Risk Management Committee of ScotDance Canada where further action may be taken.

RESTRICTED PREMIER RULES

- A Restricted Premier dancer is defined as one who has not won an overall trophy in a Premier or Restricted Premier class for two years preceding the date of the Restricted Premier event.
- ScotDance Canada defines an Overall Trophy win for Restricted Premier purposes as, "the
 dancer with the highest total number of points having competed in more than one individual
 dance in a Premier competition age group that has 6 or more competitors, thus the name of
 High Aggregate Trophy." Winners of special dances such as a Special Hornpipe or Special
 Jig, Best Dressed or Choreography event DO NOT qualify as an overall trophy win. A
 Championship and Pre-Championship are both considered a Premier event.

WAIVER

I am aware that participating in the **Glengarry Highland Games Dancing Competitions** involves the potential for risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to:

(a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and (b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.

In consideration of my / my child's participation in the Event and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS against ScotDance Canada, its directors, agents, employees, executive members, volunteers and organizers of the Event (the "Releasees"), which I now have, or hereafter may have against the Releasees. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, I agree to release the Releasees from ANY AND ALL LIABILITY for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I / my child may incur as a result of my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY OR EXPENSE, including legal costs, that the Releasees may incur due to my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, and whether caused to my child or otherwise. I understand that the Releasees will photograph and otherwise record the Event, its participants and attendees.I consent to and authorize such recording. I further consent to and authorize the Releasees to publish my/my child's image, likeness and information in any medium, including but not limited to photographs, videos, DVDs, and web-casts. I understand that this publication will take place in the public domain, including in printed materials, public announcements, and on the internet.
