## Easter Lily Dedications

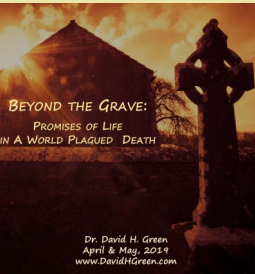
This will be the last Sunday for Easter Lily dedications. If you wish to make a dedication, please fill out the enclosed form, with your dedications printed clearly.
