**Custom Time Period Tile for the Entryway:** Amber stated that she found a company by the name of American Restoration Tile that makes time period tiles and designs the layouts. The tiles come with the grid backings already put together so one tile at a time will not have to be laid. This should make the installation much easier. Amber said the time period tile will be so much better than trying to install modern tile and the cost is very reasonable.
